

  - O June 8<sup>th</sup> ACT deadline → May 3
- O Narrow your college list & plan visits
  - Safety
  - O Reach
  - O Probable
- O Plan for a rigorous senior year curriculum
- O Ask teachers for letters of recommendation

    - Application Type
    - Common App or Not
    - Request Transcripts
  - Teacher Recommendation Requests
  - Guidance has Brag Sheet & Transcript Release form

## **Application Types**

- - Can only apply to one!
- Regular Admission



- Great opportunity for those who qualify financially
  - Typically eligible if you receive Free or Reduced lunch
- Financial Assistance AND Support Services
- Undergraduate Eligibility
  - Disadvantaged background
  - At least 12 months as a NJ resident prior to receiving the award
  - Be accepted by a participating NJ school
  - Meet school based academic criteria
  - Complete your FAFSA
  - Income based on size of household
