Dear Parent / Guardian of High School Junior or Senior,

Under the federal No Child Left Behind Act, school districts are required to provide the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of high school juniors and seniors (i.e. 17 years and older) to the United States Armed Forces Recruiting Agencies, and other authorized agencies, as requested. However, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and the No Child Left Behind Act mandate that parents be offered an option to withhold the release of this information each year. If you wish to withhold the release of your child's name, address, and telephone number, you must complete the form below and return it to the school. The request to withhold the student information is only applicable to the current school year.

I wish to request that my son / daughter's contact information (name, address, and phone number) not be released to Military Recruiters. I understand that this withholding of information will be in effect for this current academic year, and that I can revoke this option at any time by notifying my school and/or school district in writing of my decision. This is not to be taken as a request to withhold my information from school publications or from college recruiters, scholarship agencies, prospective employers, or any other entity.
